Recycle your corks by bringing them to our Fair or Craft Centre where they will be used to make our Pom-pom Pals feet!



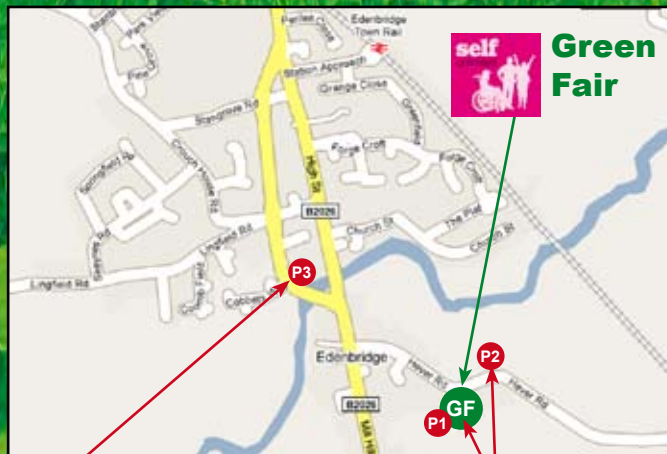

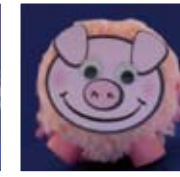
